EJIF DIVIDEND – Mr. Sacco informed the Board that the request for approval of the EJIF's \$450,000 dividend was filed with the State on October 7, 2013. We await their approval.

UNDERWRITING MANAGERS:

UGP ASSOCIATED WITH ASTs – Mr. Casagrande indicated that the compliance date deadline of July 1, 2013 has passed. He noted that the membership continues to move towards compliance. He noted that the one-time reimbursement of testing expenses up to \$400 per test is still available. He encouraged the membership to have the testing done.

UST BULLETIN – Mr. Casagrande once again informed the Committee that the E-JIF issued its annual bulletin reminding members that the Fund will no longer cover 20+ year old unregulated underground tanks after January 1, 2014. He reminded the Board that 2013 will be the last year that the Fund will cover these tanks. Mr. Casagrande added that the bulletin was mailed all members in February.

REINSURANCE RENEWALS – Mr. Casagrande indicated that the Underwriting Managers continue to negotiate the reinsurance renewal.

With nothing further, Mr. Casagrande concluded his report.

ACTUARY:

Mr. Kullman informed the Board that since the September E-JIF meeting, the Actuaries have completed their September 30th IBNR analysis. He noted that the estimates have been stable over the past 12 months. Mr. Kullman added that there have been minor variations due to new claims coming in and older claims being paid.

Mr. Covelli indicated that he had an item for the new business portion of the meeting. He informed the Board that he is the Risk Manager for Rochelle Park Township, who is a member of the South Bergen JIF. Mr. Covelli indicated that in accordance with the underground piping requirements, the township retained a firm to do the testing. The firm indicated to the township that they could remove the exposure of the underground pipes for a reasonable cost. He advised that the township spent approximately \$7,000 relocating the pipes aboveground to avoid having future issues. With that said, Mr. Covelli appealed to the Board to consider granting the township the \$400 that they would have received if they had just done the testing. The Commissioners present indicated that they did not have a problem granting the request.
